



IMPORTANT REMINDER: Preparation For Intervention Under Analgosedation

Dear Sir/Madam,

Tomorrow's intervention in our practice will be performed in the presence of an anesthesiologist and with the use of analgosedation.

For your maximum safety, please strictly adhere to the following instructions:

- **FOOD AND DRINK (MOST IMPORTANT):** You must not eat or drink anything (including water, coffee, chewing gum, or candies) for at least 4 hours before your scheduled appointment. This is crucial to preventing complications.
- **MANDATORY ESCORT:** After the intervention under sedation, you are legally and medically unfit to leave the practice on your own. It is necessary to come with an adult who will escort you home.
- **DRIVING AND ACTIVITIES:** For the next 24 hours, driving a motor vehicle, operating machinery, or making important decisions is strictly prohibited.
- **HEALTH STATUS:** If you have developed a fever, cough, runny nose, or feel sick in the last few days, please notify us immediately.
- **REGULAR THERAPY:** Take your regular medications at the usual time with a very small sip of water, unless the surgeon or anesthesiologist has told you otherwise (this especially applies to diabetes and blood-thinning medications).
- **CLOTHING:** Wear something comfortable with short sleeves or sleeves that can be easily rolled up for easier access to the vein.
